

City Council Meeting

Wednesday January 14, 2026

The City of Bromley met in a regular session on Wednesday December 10, 2025 @ 6:00pm, with a pledge to the flag and Mayor Denham presiding.

Roll Call- Council members present: Mike Kendall, Andrew Clift, Dave Radford, Tim Wartman, Dianne Wartman and Kelly Dudley.

Call to Order- Staff present: Matt Woods City Attorney, Police Chief Cody Stanley, Fire Chief Mike Steward, Public Works Jack Dudley, City Clerk Brittany Hinzman

Approval of minutes- Motion to approve minutes, Tim Wartman first, Mike Kendall second. All in favor, Yes.

Speaker- Amanda Peters- I SERVE as the director of NKY office of drug control policy. Part of why I am here is to see if there is a need for a program to serve the city of Bromley. We are rolling out a program to provide assist for majority of our tri state cities. This will allow for a police social worker to work with schools, community members and anyone else who may be having any issues with substance abuse, alcohol abuse, falls, food insecurity, etc. No financial obligation from the city of Bromley and you would be assigned your own designated social worker. NKY HELPLINE is called to determine needs and services. Motion to agree with joining this interlocal agreement- Mike Kendall first, Andy Clift second, all in favor, yes.

Citizens Report – Gail Smith Boone Street- I was wondering if you would be willing to adjust the agenda so that the citizen report move to the end of the meeting in case there are questions? Also did we finally settle with BP on the 75k? When I was looking at financials it was not included in the expenditure. Mike Kendall- Terri Stahl is actively working on this. What are the bids in the paper for? Mayor- we are replacing the rubber matting around the swing sets. Is there money in the budget? Dianne- we have a donation of 60k. One other thing- I have noticed there are some campers up around the trailer park. Andy- they are approaching their 30 days, PDS is keeping his eye on it.

PDS- Andy Clift – Not many complaints right now. 219 Rohman was a big issue. The back privacy fence collapsed a lot of debris and collapsed porch. It has been purchased and a rental dumpster is being placed to clean up. 3 Pike had a temporary structure, this was flagged and so they received fines, and the tenants were evicted. 1762 highwater has some abandoned vehicles, they have reached \$11,550 in fines. 214 Main sold and liens have been paid. 214 Shelby had overgrowth, mail returned, and PDS is marked vacant. To be determined. I have met with PDS re: zoning changes to ability to sell property along the river. Mike Kendall motion to amend and complete application, Andy Clift first, Tim Wartman second, all in favor yes. We must complete and file an amendment with PDS for change. Regarding the AIRBNB ordinance ie: short term rentals, this too would require an amendment. Current zoning does not allow for short-term rentals in Bromley. Mayor to read drafter ordinance before motion to vote. 305 Main is pending foreclosure. 102 Kenton, owner has to be contacted and served to allow for a response.
