ORDINANCE NO. 9-1-24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BROMLEY CREATING A NEW SECTION OF CHAPTER 93 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BROMLEY PROHIBITING THE USE OF FIREWORKS IN THE CITY PARK.

WHEREAS: The City of Bromley has expended considerable funds improving and adding to the Bromley City Park located generally North of Shelby Street and South of Pike Street in the City, and

WHEREAS: The City Council, in order to assure the safety of persons and property in the Park and to prohibit damage to all surfaces in the Park,

Now, therefore, be it ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BROMLEY, KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

That an new section of Chapter 93 of the official code of ordinances of the City of Bromley is added to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to cause fireworks as defined in this Chapter be set off at any time within the confines of the Bromley City Park.

SECTION II

Any person who violates any provision of Section One of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$250.00 for a first offense and if a person is convicted of a second offense committed within two (2) years of conviction of a first offense such person shall be fined not more than \$500.00 or imprisoned for not more than 30 days, or both.

SECTION III

All ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION IV

The invalidity of any section, subsection, or sentence or the ordinance shall not
